Sec. 919. (1) The measure of the compensation of members of

 CLIENT, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED OTHERWISE BY LAW OR BY regulation of the
 supreme court.

6 (2) Any AN agreement for such compensation , OF AN ATTORNEY AT
7 LAW or for reimbursement of any expenses , incident to INCURRED BY
8 AN ATTORNEY IN the prosecution or defense of any A claim by any
9 party is wholly void if such professional THE employment was

 ATTORNEY, unless the services of such member of the bar THE

4 (3) IF AN ATTORNEY AT LAW ENTERS INTO AN EXPRESS OR IMPLIED 5 AGREEMENT TO PROSECUTE A CLAIM FOR PERSONAL INJURY OR WRONGFUL 6 DEATH THAT PROVIDES THAT THE ATTORNEY'S COMPENSATION IS CONTINGENT 7 IN WHOLE OR IN PART ON SUCCESSFUL PROSECUTION OR SETTLEMENT OF THE 8 CLAIM OR ON THE AMOUNT OF RECOVERY, THE ATTORNEY SHALL NOT RECEIVE, 9 RETAIN, OR SHARE A FEE THAT IS MORE THAN \$1,000,000.00, REGARDLESS 10 OF THE PERCENTAGE OF THE AMOUNT RECOVERED INVOLVED.
